Here are a few school procedures for your information

Absences and Illness

For safety reasons, the school must be contacted if your child is going to be absent. Please telephone the school office before 9.15 on the day your child is to be absent and leave a message on our absence line (please include your child's name, room number and reason for their absence). Alternatively, email office@pukenui.school.nz, text us on 022 087 4424, or message us on facebook. Unreported absences are followed up from school, usually by phone and sometimes by the Truancy Officer. The phone in/follow up system ensure the whereabouts and that the safety of children is known.

Before School

Students who arrive before 8.30am are to sit outside room 1 & 2 until bell.

After School

Children must leave the school grounds as soon as they are dismissed from class, unless accompanied by an adult. Children are not kept in unless parents have been notified. Children may return to play in school grounds from 4pm.

Lunch Pass

Children are not permitted to leave the school grounds during lunch breaks without a note from home, unless stated on enrolment form they have a lunch pass.

Money and Cellphones at School

Cellphones etc are NOT permitted at school. Please hand into the school office on arrival for safe keeping and can be collected at the end of the day. When the children bring money to school for school activities, fundraising, stationery etc, it is important that the money is in a sealed envelope, and has written on the outside the following information: Name, Room Number, amount and what the money is for. It is especially important for Junior children to observe this. All money should be handed into the office before school.

School Lunches

A Lunch List is available from the office and additional copies can be obtained to take home. The children can place their order at the office in the morning. The lunches are then collected from the foyer by the class VIP at the beginning of Lunch break. Change will be handed out at the same time or held at the office until the end of day.
